The Problem

- Bike theft is rampant:
 Over 250,000 bikes stolen annually in the UK most unreported, <10% recovered
- Poor protection at home: 62% of thefts happen outside houses — sheds, racks, and hangers offer little deterrence
- Active travel schemes are stalling still at 2% for cycling regardless of major investment
- High-value losses: E-bikes (£2k+) and premium bikes are frequent targets
- Shared storage isn't working: Communal lockers are inconvenient, insecure, and exclude many users
- The result? Cyclists feel unsafe, ride less, or give up entirely blocking progress in active travel and micromobility

Despite billions invested, the UK has just 2% cycling uptake — active travel isn't working alone. Bike schemes mainly focus on inner-cities, leaving suburban riders are left behind. With theft rampant, no true metre-tometre infrastructure, and security at home a leading barrier especially for suburban and flat-dwellers, expensive bikes stay unused. myBikeCloud is the missing link that makes active travel work and metre-to-metre cycling possible







The Solution: myBikeCloud

- Secure, elevated, easy quick access and modular storage for multiple bicycles of any type including e-bikes, cargo bikes and trikes.
- Electric hoist with wireless control lifts bikes off the ground for space-saving, antitheft protection.
- Designed to be Solar-powered & off-grid ready (battery storage, future wind add-on), not tied to a mains power source if one is not available
- Expandable: app-based security with camera integration, rental sharing, lighting, custom branding, tow bar hitch and maintenance stand incorporated
- Wall-mounted design with tough ACP/GRP or plastic casings with modular manufacture for rapid scale-up and interchangeable casings.
